This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information request dated March 21, 2007. Attached is a copy of the police report and dispatch generated calls for a response or extra patrol to the home of Christian Trejbal on March 13, 2007. In addition, your request was for witness statements and/ or e-mails from the following Emergency Services entities: Christiansburg Police, Va. State Bomb Squad and the Christiansburg Fire Department. We have no such e-mails or statements that were created from these contacts or civilian witnesses. However, there are recorded audio conversations between these respective agencies. This agency does not normally transcribe audio recordings that are not of a criminal nature. Thus, we reserve the right under the standards of the Freedom of Information Act to only supply a copy of the audio recordings.

I was called to 675 School Lane to take a report of a suspicious package. I was met by Christian Trejbal. He explained that he was a reporter for the Roanoke Times and that he had been receiving threats since an article came out in the paper on Sunday 3/10/07. He said the article had been about concealed hand-guns, and that the paper had published a list on their website of all the people that have a permit to carry concealed. He said the repose was to the point where the paper took the list off the website. Mr. Trejbal said that today he noticed a package on his front porch that he did not order. He was sure that he did not order anything and was not expecting a package. He thought the box looked suspicious. He said that it was not there yesterday. He said that a security guard was at his home during the night and was sure it was not there. The box had a small label that appeared to have been delivered by the company, "DHL." Several other officer's and supervisor's responded to the scene also. Ofc. Roop spoke to a DHL driver just up the street and he said he believed he had delivered the package yesterday. I spoke to a neighbor across the street and she said she saw the DHL truck back in the drive-way and put the box on the porch today. We spoke to Mr. Trejbal further and he advised that a big reason that he thought the box was suspicious was that it had his old phone number from Oregon on it, and he believed it could have came off the internet. The box was labeled as containing shipping materials and he insisted that he never ordered and never has ordered anything like that. Christian also said that no one at the office would have ordered that either. We were able to confirm through DHL (Trey Hellums [REDACTED]) that the items were packed and shipped out from their warehouse and had been ordered though the internet by someone acting as Mr. Trejbal. There had been four orders of the envelopes exactly alike. They said they could not track what computer it was ordered from. The label on the package did not look like the other DHL labels. Lt. Ramsey was able to confirm that the bar-code seemed to be valid, again through the DHL officials. He also checked with the driver again and got his information (It's listed in the witness section) They checked in his computer and it had indeed been delivered today, at 10:30am. Since we still could not confirm if the package was legitimate we closed off the streets, and contacted the State Police. They advised they would have a bomb tech unit and a bomb K-9 in route to our location. They responded and the first thing they did was x-ray the box. It appeared to have envelopes in it. Gus Necessary of the state police, said that it did not look like anything explosive. He went ahead and opened the box. It only contained envelopes. The canine handler also ran the dog on the box and he did not alert. The street was re-opened. During this investigation, Mr. Trejbal had said more about the threats. He said he had received threats over his voice mails

at work, threatening e-mails, and threats over the blogs on the Roanoke Times Web site. He was asked if he had reported the threats and he said that security from the news paper had reported it. Dispatch was able to confirm that they had called in on 03-12-07. They did not file a report, they just requested extra patrol for awhile . (CFS # 2007-009338) One specific threat had stated "watch your back, not all citizens abide by the law." Detective Brown talked to Mr. Trejbal further about the specific threats. He advised that he would follow up on the threats and planned to meet him at the Roanoke Times office to retrieve copies of the threats. We will continue to provide extra patrol. I will attach any other needed information to the report.

SHIPPING ENVELOPES W/DHL LABEL SENT TO VICTIM

On 03-14-07 I had a meeting with Dennis "Chip" Harris and Joe Huddleston with the Roanoke Times. They brought me a Flyer that was shipped by Email to them. This flyer was sent by the American National Socialist Workers Party (Bill White in Roanoke A known White activist). They also tuned over email from the blog after the article. they had concerns over Mr. White and possible

problem with concern of the victim safety. I contacted Chief Reid and Lt. Sisson about the information

Note: A meeting took place to fill in Chief Reid about the possible threats. He spoke with Lt Sisson and told him to contact the State Police and FBI. I called and spoke again to Chip and he told me that the threat of a planned protest. At this time that is only a rumor and there has been nothing uncovered that is going to take place.

03-14-07 I had a meeting with Mary Peditt at the CA Office. I showed her all of the email that I had, she told me at this time she did not see any that would constitute a threat under the code of Virginia.

03-14-07 I called and spoke with Mr. Trejbal, he sent me another email that said that "If someone was hurt do to his making public the list he would be killed. I spoke with Mary once again and she told me that in her opinion it was not a direct threat toward the victim.
